He identified that a single home, with a history of increased lead levels, was provided with a letter with instructions to assist with further reducing lead in their home, including flushing the lines, filtering, and replacing pipes in the home.

The Chief Financial Officer reviewed the report and highlighted that the year remained a strong, with strong liquidity, operating capital, and a rebounding sinking fund.

A Commissioner inquired about the water revenue and the uptake of usage. The Chief Financial Officer responded that the revenue increased due to an increase in customers during the year.

A Commissioner inquired about the economic growth of the region and usage increases with an anticipated upcoming commercial customer. Management confirmed that a high uptake is anticipated. Some preliminary analysis has been completed, but Management remains cautiously optimistic as the industry is welcomed to the region. WUC remains ready to service this new growth. More information will be provided to the Board in the future when more details are available.
